

## Acknowledging AMSIC instructors and student's directors

- Africa's higher education systems are overwhelmed by the sharp enrollment uptake There were 4.8 million students in 2019; this number could reach 8. 3 million in 2025 Student population could increase by 72% in just six years! Access to quality education will significantly impact trainee's career path and their professional contributions
- 2. 200 million of Africa youth are between the age of 15 and 25 AMSIC teachers can provide invaluable assistance to the small fraction that will pursue higher education studies currently less than 15% of Africa's youth.
- 3. One year of quality education is equivalent to 10% increase in wages
- 4. AMSIC teachers get an opportunity to build new professional connections across Africa's 55 countries.
- 5. Higher education programs in Africa offer very few undergrad courses on membranes. Hence, AMSIC courses will address some unmet needs.
